

ABSTRAK

Skripsi ini berjudul “**Kalimat Ekslamatif Dalam Naskah Film *Shrek Series: Shrek 1 – 3* Karya *William Steig* dan *Ted Elliott* : Kajian Sintaktis dan Semantis**”. Tujuan penelitian ini adalah untuk menemukan tipe-tipe, mengklasifikasikan struktur kalimat ekslamatif, serta menjelaskan makna kalimat ekslamatif dengan memusatkan pada teori sintaktis dan semantis.

Pada penelitian ini, penulis menggunakan metode deskriptif analisis dengan mengikuti prosedur berikut ini: mengumpulkan data kalimat ekslamatif yang terdapat pada naskah film *Shrek 1 – 3* yang ditulis oleh *William Steig* dan *Ted Elliott*, menganalisis data berdasarkan teori dari *William O’Grady et al* (1996), *Randolp Quirk* (1982), *Michael Swan* (1997), *James McCawley* (1998) dan *Leonard Bloomfield* (1995) kemudian mengambil kesimpulan dari data tersebut.

Hasil dari penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa secara sintaktis kalimat ekslamatif terdiri atas tiga tipe yaitu *Inverted Exclamative Sentence*, *Wh-Exclamative Sentence*, dan *So-Exclamative Sentence*. Struktur kalimat ekslamatif terdiri dari *Exclamative Sentence with How*, *Exclamative Sentence with What*, *Exclamative Sentence with So and Such* dan *Exclamative Sentence with Negative Question Form*. Secara semantis, data yang mengandung kalimat ekslamatif memiliki makna kontekstual yang bergantung pada situasi bahasa.

ABSTRACT

The title of this paper is “Kalimat Ekslamatif Dalam Naskah Film Shrek Series: Shrek 1 – 3 Karya William Steig dan Ted Elliott: Kajian Sintaktis dan Semantis”. The purposes of this research are to find out types of exclamative sentence, classify structure of exclamative sentence, and explain meaning of exclamative sentence by concentrating on syntactic and semantic theories.

In this research, the writer uses descriptive-analytical method with the following procedures: collecting the data of exclamative sentence in the Shrek 1 – 3 script movies written by William Steig and Ted Elliott, analyzing data based on theory from William O’Grady et al (1996), Randolp Quirk (1982), Michael Swan (1997), James McCawley (1998) and Leonard Bloomfield (1995), and then making a conclusion from these data.

The results of this research show that syntactically exclamative sentence consists of three types. They are Inverted Exclamative Sentence, Wh-Exclamative Sentence, and So-Exclamative Sentence. Exclamative sentence structure consists of Exclamative Sentence with How, Exclamative Sentence with What, Exclamative Sentence with So and Such and Exclamative Sentence with Negative Question Form. Semantically, the data in terms of the exclamative sentence has contextual meaning depending on the language situation.
